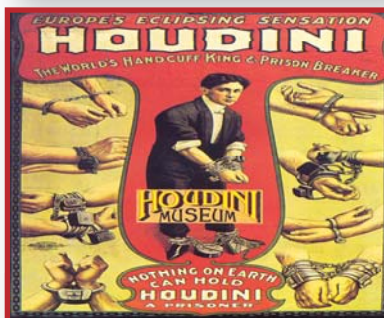
### Cooper's Seafood Scranton
