Frederick Stegmaier Mansion

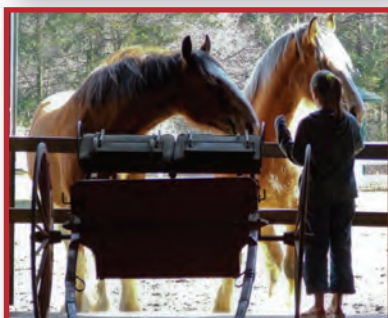

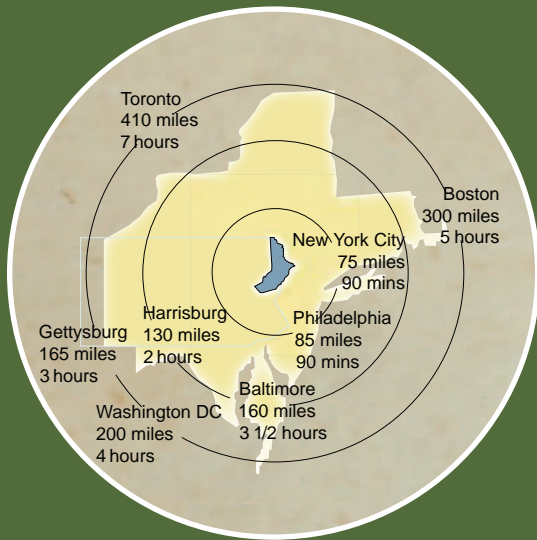
The Lands at Hillside Farms

9:30 am: Asa Packer Mansion

A National Historic Landmark and home of philanthropist and railroad magnate Asa Packer. Built in the Victorian Italianate architecture style in 1861, this beautiful home was the residence of Asa Packer and his family. Among his many accomplishments, the multi-millionaire built the Lehigh Valley Railroad and founded Lehigh University. View the personal possessions as you tour the 3 story, 18 rooms and 11,000 square foot of living space.

11:00 am: Lehigh Gorge Scenic Railway

Ride the rails on a one hour train ride into the beautiful Lehigh Gorge State Park. From the comfort of historic 1920's era open window coaches, you can witness the grand sights available only by train. Mountain vistas, trackside streams, the flowing Lehigh River and fellow adventurers hiking, biking and whitewater rafting are a few of the views aboard the Lehigh Gorge Scenic Railway.

12:30 pm: Dine in the 1860 Albright Mansion's Crave at 66.

Experience food, spirits, authentic English Tea and the rich history. Located on Millionaire's Row, the Albright Mansion hosted President Grant in 1872. Current hosts offer genuine hospitality and an eclectic menu for your group.

2:00 pm: Victorian House Tour Sprinkled with Shopping

Stroll the streets of Old Mauch Chunk and tour homes, churches, Mauch Chunk Opera House, Mauch Chunk Museum and Cultural Center admiring the elegant Victorian architecture while learning of the rich industrial heritage of the region. Broadway, Millionaire's Row and Stone Row are lined with art galleries, cafés and unique shopping.
